The Assistant Executive Director assists the Executive Director in a variety of tasks regarding the administration and management of the organization. Performs highly responsible administrative and management work in planning, directing and coordination of FIND's grant programs. Works closely with the Executive Director and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to plan, coordinate, and execute a dredge material management program to meet the requirements for maintenance of the Intracoastal and Okeechobee Waterways.

Experience with marine permitting, marine infrastructure design or construction experience

Grant writing and administrative experience

Knowledge of Florida's Waterways and/or Marine Industry

College Degree in engineering, marine or environmental studies or another related field or 8+ years' experience in grant management, dredging or environmental permitting

3+ years' experience in management

Personal computer operations and Microsoft programs proficiency

- Manage and coordinate the FIND grant programs

- Assist in the permitting and construction of newly acquired dredged material management sites and dredging projects
