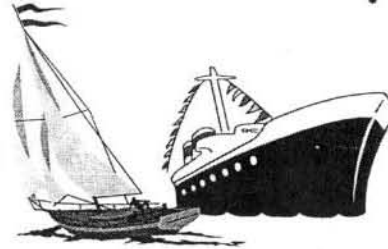

## WHAT AND WHERE CONCERNING THE DREDGING PROJECT


1. Mariners are hereby notified to use caution, when navigating Fernandina Harbor/Kings Bay Entrance Channel, Cut1N in Nassau County, FL and Camden County, GA.

2. Specific Info about project: O&M dredging will occur in the federal channel from the jetties to approximately 7 nm seaward. Project limits are from Cut1N Sta 80+00 to Sta 470+00. Approximately 1.2 million cubic yards of material will be dredged. Placement locations include an Ocean Dredged Material Disposal Site (ODMDS) that is located approximately 14 miles south east of the project, the groin field adjacent to Fort Clinch, the jetty located within Fort Clinch Park, and potentially the northern portion of Fernandina Beach. Hopper dredge plants will be used. Dredging may occur anytime from 01 Dec 2009 through 15 March 2010.

3. (GENERIC CAUTION TO MARINERS) Mariners should operate vessels with caution in the area due to potential for floating debris, increased traffic due to the operation, and large equipment working in and along the waterway.
