



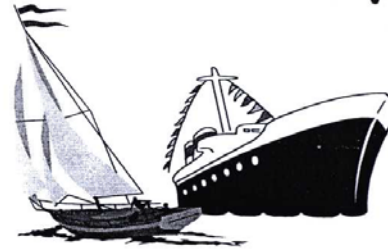

Maintenance Dredging, 12-ft Project, Palm Valley, North Reach
Intracoastal Waterway Jacksonville to Miami, FL St. Johns County

1. Mariners are hereby notified to use caution, when navigating the Intracoastal Waterway from the Duval/St. Johns County Line to the Palm Valley Bridge, FL.
2. The project is located on the east coast of Florida in St. Johns County, about 11 miles south of the mouth of the St. Johns River. The Government will be performing maintenance dredging work along the waterway. Approximately 217,000 cubic yards (CY) of material will be placed in the existing DU-9 Dredge Material Management Area (DMMA). A cutter suction dredge with attached pipeline barges and boats will be used to perform the dredging operation. The project will last 245 days and is scheduled to commence on August 31, 2009.
3. Mariners should operate vessels with caution in the area due to potential for floating debris, increased traffic due to the operation, and large equipment working in and along the waterway.
