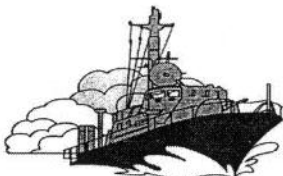




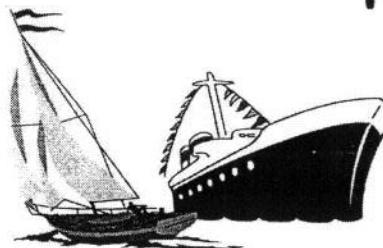



Maintenance Dredging, 33-ft Project, Palm Beach Harbor
Palm Beach County, Florida

1. Mariners are hereby notified to use caution, when navigating the Intracoastal Waterway from Peanut Island to the Port of Palm Beach, FL.
2. The project consists of dredging from the Palm Beach Harbor entrance channel, settling basins, Cut-1, Cut-2, and the North and South Turning Basins. An ocean certified hopper dredge will be used to perform the dredging operations. The work also includes endangered species observer/monitoring, sea turtle trawling, and turbidity monitoring. All material removed during this event shall be placed in the Nearshore beach disposal area south of the Entrance channel jetty. The project will last approximately 70 days and is scheduled to commence on August 17, 2009.
3. Mariners should operate vessels with caution in the area due to potential for floating debris, increased traffic due to the operation, and large equipment working in and along the waterway.
