

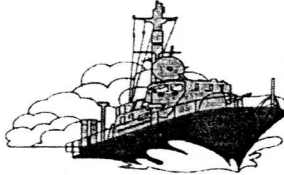

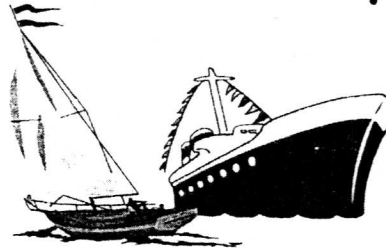

## NAVIGATION RESTRICTIONS LIFTED

### OKEECHOBEE WATERWAY, FLORIDA

1. This notice is a revision to notice dated 29 August 2008 which supercede notices dated 30 May 2007 and 30 January 2008.
2. Mariners are hereby notified all previous posted restrictions have been lifted regarding:
  - a) the lack of sufficient draft of Lake Okeechobee Route 1
  - b) the limited scheduled lockages at St Lucie and W. P. Franklin
3. Normal operations are now in place from 6:00am to 9:30pm daily allowing lockages on demand for commercial and recreational vessels.
4. Route 2 (the Rim Canal) remains closed to navigation due to the uncharted debris from previous hurricanes.
5. Due to the current hurricane season, mariners are advised normal navigation through OWW could change on short notice due to direct and indirect effects from storm systems.
6. The following table gives lake elevation and corresponding navigation depth at a glance for Route 1.
